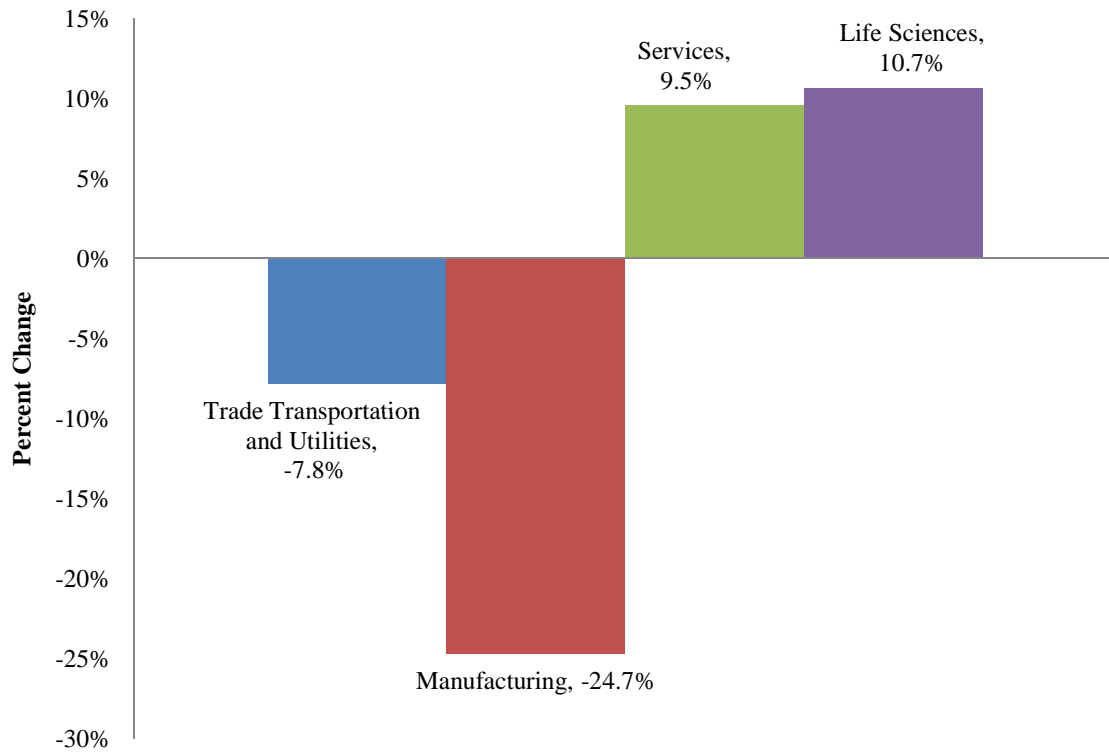


## Change in Employment by Major Industry in Michigan, 1999-2006

*Data Note: Between 1999 and 2006, the businesses previously classified as "Auxiliaries" was reclassified by their primary business activity and redistributed across the other NAICS codes. The life sciences industry was adjusted to reflect this change, and for the purposes of this graph, a portion of auxiliaries were apportioned to Services (90%) and Trade, Transportation and Utilities (10%) based on the 12 NAICS codes affected by the reclassification. Services includes professional and business services, health and education, as well as leisure, hospitality, food, arts and recreation.*
