Katie Turnbull is an Executive Associate Director at the Texas A&M Transportation Institute (TTI). She is also an Executive Professor in the Department of Landscape Architecture and Urban Planning at Texas A&M University. At TTI she maintains a diverse research portfolio, leads Institute initiatives, and manages TTI's Environment and Planning Research Group. Active in the Transportation Research Board (TRB) of the National Academies of Sciences, Engineering, and Medicine, she is currently serving as the Vice Chair of the TRB Executive Committee. Turnbull received the Regents Fellow Award from Texas A&M University System in 2015. In 2014, she was recognized with TRB's W.N. Carey, Jr. Distinguished Service Award, recognizing her long-time outstanding service to TRB and transportation research. In 2013, she received the Ethel S. Birchland Lifetime Achievement Award from the American Road and Transportation Builders Association (ARTBA), which honors

individuals who promote leadership and career advancement for women in the transportation design and construction industries. In 2012, she was named a lifetime national associate of the National Research Council based on her many years of volunteer service with TRB.
